Have you ever questioned if those names they've given us in the Scriptures are the real names? If not, that's okay. Many others haven't either.

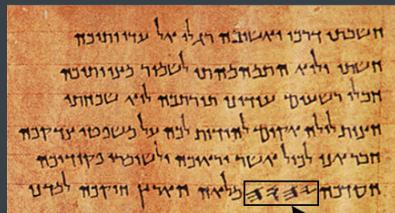

## So what's The TRUE Name of the Creator?

Over the years, old texts have been discovered, proving the existence of a Creator and an origin of life. These texts also prove prophecies and one other important key point, language.



Ancient Hebrew is found to be the first language. This is important, because we know where the origins of words come from along with the pronunciation of NAMES.

Names do not get translated from language to language. Words may be translated, but names do not. For example, if you visit another country, your name is still pronounced the same even in a different language!

The Creator Says, "This is My Name Forever"

YAHUAH

The True Name of the Creator in modern Hebrew is written as יהוה. And in Ancient Hebrew it is shown in the image above. It is pronounced "YAH-OO-AH". YAHUAH himself told us about His Name in Scripture.

When Mushah (Moses) was on the mountain with the Creator, he asked the Creator... "See, when I come to the children of Yashra'al (Israel) and say to them, 'The Mighty One of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His Name?' what shall I say to them?"

*"Thus you are to say to the children of Yashra'al, 'YAHUAH the Aluah (Mighty One) of your fathers, the Aluah of Abraham, the Aluah of Yahsaac (Isaac), and the Aluah of Yahcub (Jacob), has sent me to you. This is My Name forever, and this is My remembrance to all generations."*
